



ADOPT-A-PARK PROGRAM

Oakdale's "Adopt-A-Park" program is designed to help keep city parks well maintained. This is a great activity for individuals, families, organizations, churches, service clubs, youth groups, schools, and businesses. The process is easy: Select the park you would like to adopt, contact the Parks Division at (651) 730-2740 to verify the park is available, then complete the attached application and submit it to the Parks Division, 1900 Hadley Avenue North, Oakdale, MN 55128, to finalize the process.

Responsibilities of Adoptee:

- 1 Clean up your park (or designated public area) a minimum of two (2) times during the year, for a minimum of two (2) years. (Suggested: fall cleanup, spring cleanup or summer cleanup). Notify the Parks Division at (651) 730-2740 one week prior to the planned clean up event.
- 2 Pick up paper, cans, glass (broken glass to be removed at the discretion of the group supervisor), and other garbage.
- 3 Provide on-site supervision in the form of at least one adult over the age of 18.
- 4 Schedule clean up event during daylight hours.
- 5 The city will provide trash bags, when requested and dispose of all trash collected in a timely manner.
- 6 Filled trash bags should be placed in a pre-designated area for pick up by the city.
- 7 Any other proposed park improvements, developments, or plans must first be approved by the City Council.

Volunteer groups will be recognized for their activities in the following ways:

An Adopt-A-Park sign will be posted by the Parks Division identifying the City of Oakdale, the designated park name, and the sponsoring group name.
